The EFRI course provides students with the training necessary to become instructors in Primary Care/Secondary Care, CPR, first-aid, and Care for Children. The EFRI certification is a prerequisite required before attending the IE - the culmination of the OWSI COI.

The vocational objective of this course is for the students to earn and receive the EFRI rating and certification, which is widely recognized as the leading emergency first response training program in the world.
